TRADEcho 3.7 Release Production Go-Live – 14 December 2020

Further to the announcement, [001/14102020](#), the purpose of this Service Announcement is to inform customers that the TRADEcho 3.7 production release go-live will be on **Monday 14 December 2020**.

TRADEcho release 3.7 includes the following changes:

- New FIX tag (27020) for base 10 TVTIC to assist transaction reporting customers
- APA and SRR trade search will now return 5,000 rows
- Assisted reports can now be sent to BATS via CSV
- SecondaryFirmTradeID (tag 1042) added to TCR-S and TCR-C messages
