Pre-Trading Session Start Time Change

The purpose of this Service Announcement is to provide customers with notification of a change to the London Stock Exchange where the **Pre-Trading** session start times are being brought forward to 05:05 (London Time).

This change is due to be released in the CDS environment effective **Wednesday 9 October 2019**. It will be introduced in Production on **Monday 11 November 2019** subject to successful testing.

The 'ODTT' Regular Trading and 'TEST' Pre-Mandatory times will be adjusted accordingly from 07:01 to 05:06. Test orders and test quotes in these segments will be accepted at this earlier time.

Customers can expect to see instrument halt messages via the GTP Instrument Status message disseminated at 05:05. Also, any GTD cancellations or expiries can occur at 05:05.

As is currently required, sponsoring firms must be logged in with their monitoring Drop Copy user before the Pre-Trading session commences to avoid expiry of their sponsored users' GTD orders.
