Notification of new rule - Central Securities Depositories Regulation (CSDR) Article 3

Introduction

1. This Notice is published further to Stock Exchange Notices N08/14 and N12/14 which discussed the EU Regulation on Central Securities Depositories (CSDR), the requirements of Article 3 and its impact on the Rules of the London Stock Exchange (“the Exchange” and “the rules”).

Proposed new rule

2. N12/14 confirmed the Exchange’s intention to introduce a new rule requiring order book trades to be settled electronically in order to be compliant with CSDR Article 3(2). As a result, Attachment 1 to this Notice contains the proposed new rule together with a new definition. Standard notification procedures (Datasync) will be used in relation to any securities which will change segment/sector as a result of the implementation of this rule.
3. As stated in N12/14 Regulation S, Category 3 securities, will be excluded from the new rule until 1 June 2015. These securities will remain in their current trading service sectors and the Exchange will continue to work with Euroclear UK & Ireland, affected issuers and their advisers towards an electronic settlement solution.

Effective date

4. The new rule and definition as detailed in Attachment 1 will become effective from Monday 5 January 2015.
