## London Stock Exchange Next Functional Release 9.6.12 Go-Live Update

Further to our communications [001/060921](#) and [001/29072021](#), the purpose of this Service Announcement is to notify clients that the London Stock Exchange production go-live date, for the next functional release 9.6.12, is now scheduled for **Monday 1 November 2021**, and no longer for Monday 18 October as previously announced.

As a reminder, London Stock Exchange functional release, 9.6.12, will include:

- Request for Quote 'RFQ' Market Maker Ranking function, to allow RFQ requestors to automatically route their requests to RFQ market makers based on ranking. Where a requestor inputs a specific rank, all RFQ Market Makers at that rank or higher will receive the RFQ. To be enabled for this functionality, contact your Technical Account Manager or the Technical Account Management team [londontam@lseg.com](mailto:londontam@lseg.com).
- Native and FIX, to preserve data integrity on the below fields, the valid range of ASCII characters will be 0 and 32-126, with the exception of "#", "/", ";", "\"". London Stock Exchange will replace characters outside of this range, and the listed characters, with "-" in Trade Capture Report messages sent to clients and to CCPs.

- Native, Length of Buy Side Order Quantity and Sell Side Order Quantity fields on New Order Cross and Cross Order Cancel Request messages have been reduced to UInt32 and the remaining field length has been reserved for future use. The length of the messages remains the same.

Conformance testing is mandatory for customers who make software changes to support this release.

Customers should provide final readiness sign-off to their Technical Account Manager or the Technical Account Management team.
