## TRADEcho 3.7.6 Release Production Go-Live – 22 March 2021

Further to the announcement, [001/10022021](#), the purpose of this Service Announcement is to inform customers that the TRADEcho 3.7.6 production release go-live will be on **Monday 22 March 2021**.

As a reminder, TRADEcho release 3.7.6 includes the following changes:

- Customer automated regeneration of TRADEcho reports - customers will be able to regenerate EOD and weekly files within the previous 30 days directly from the portal. Customers must be subscribed to the reports for the dates requested.
- Technical Account Management (TAM) and Support teams automated regeneration of TRADEcho reports older than 30 days. Customers will be able to request regeneration of EOD files older than 30 days. Customers must be subscribed for the dates requested.
- Amended SRR logic to populate venue of execution field.
