TRADEcho 3.8 Release Production Go-Live – 28 June 2021

Further to the announcement, [001/11052021](#), the purpose of this Service Announcement is to inform customers that the TRADEcho 3.8 production release go-live will be on **Monday 28 June 2021**.

As a reminder, TRADEcho release 3.8 includes the following changes:

- Allow further processing of reports in Manual Deferral when Pending Price = Y. Currently this is not permitted.
- Assisted Report Trades will now be included in the EOD Full and SUMMARY APA reports.
- Added support for Tradeweb SIMarketID (FIX tag 25081) – only available on Tradeweb from Monday 28th June 2021 (UAT) and Monday 12th July 2021 (Production). The tag will map to the TE SiMic (FIX tag 25026) or be taken from the SI Register according to the existing TE logic.
