## TRADEcho Customer Development Service Upgrade 3.9 Release – Friday 27 August 2021

The purpose of this Service Announcement is to inform customers that the TRADEcho Customer Development Service (CDS) will be upgraded to TRADEcho 3.9 on **Friday 27 August 2021**. The TRADEcho CDS environment will be unavailable on this day and customers will not be able to connect. It is expected that the environment will be available as usual on **Tuesday 31 August 2021**.

TRADEcho release 3.9 includes the following changes:

- Allow Trade Reports to have 5 decimal places for Quantity and Quantity in Measurement Unit attributes.
- Introduction of a Chatbot to the TRADEcho Portal to help users with answers to queries.
- Addition of TOTV columns as filter attributes in TRADEcho Portal Instrument page.
- The introduction of Save and Load Filter in all pages of the TRADEcho Portal wherever the feature is available.
